Lambs were presented in good bloom to a packed ringside of bidders. Trade for all classes was up on the year with prices for middle draws seeing the biggest increase. Topping the trade at £134 was a pen of quality ewe lambs from J W Kay & Co., Gass, Straiton. Next at £128 was a pen from W Wallace & Sons, Fingland followed at £112 from Knockdon and £110 from Craig, Straiton and Balmurrie (twice). Overall sale average levelled at £78.59 for 3176 compared to £74.36 for 2962.
