



**WALLETS MARTS CASTLE DOUGLAS LIMITED
MONDAY 10TH OCTOBER 2016
BREEDING CATTLE, OTM CATTLE**

Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited sold 39 OTM Cattle and 106 Breeding Cattle at their fortnightly sale on Monday 10th October 2016.

Breeding Cattle met a good demand with quality outfits regularly selling in excess of £2000. Topping the sale at £2150 was a Limousin heifer with a bull calf at foot from J Fisher, Flathill, Dundrennan. Flathill annual consignment of 20 heifers with calves averaged £1876.48. Also forward were 14 heifers with calves from J A Fingland, Garmartin which sold to £1950 and averaged £1646.42. Cows with calves sold to £1600 for an AAx with a heifer calf from Cogarth. Bulling heifers topped at £850 for Galloways from Mrs O Repton, Auchencairn, Closeburn. 8 cows with calves averaged £1093.75. 44 Heifers with calves averaged £1707.28.

A plainer show of OTM cattle were presented to the usual busy ringside of bidders with prices holding up well in the live ring compared to dead weight. Topping the sale at £1199.70 or 190ppkg was a Simmental heifer from Park of Tongland. Cows topped at 133p for a Simmental from Culnaightrie. Overage bullocks sold to 132p or £987.36 for a Galloway from Auchencairn, Closeburn. Overall average for OTM Cattle was 115.22p.
