



**WALLETS MARTS CASTLE DOUGLAS LIMITED
MONDAY 19th JUNE 2017
STORE AND OTM CATTLE**

Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited had forward 44 store and OTM cattle at their fortnightly sale of Monday 19th June 2017.

30 OTM cattle were one of the best shows of well grazed cows to be seen for some considerable time. This resulted in the dearest average for cows ever recorded at this centre when the 30 OTM's averaged 159.94p per kg or £1079.55 per head. Topping the trade at £1377.24 was a Hereford Bull from Mayhaar. An AAx heifer from the same home made 188p or £1216.36 whilst cast cows topped at 179p for a South Devon from Garrarie and to £1354.64 for a British Blue cross from Trolane.

A small but select show of store cattle were presented to a keen ringside resulting in a sound trade for everything sold. An Aberdeen Angus cross heifer from Trolane topped the sale at £1220. Bullocks topped at 238p per kg or £1035 for Simmentals from Graplin Farms. Hereford bullocks from Mayhaar sold to £980 or 218.8p with Aberdeen Angus from the same home making £940 or 220.2p per kg.
