Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited on Monday 3rd July 2017 had forward 73 Store and OTM cattle at their fortnightly sale.

39 OTM cattle were again a good show for quality with only the plainest cows looking less. Top today was £1647.75 or 169ppk for a Limousin Bull from Cardoness and Kings Laggan. Cows topped at £1443.26 for an Angus again from Culnaightrie with a Hereford cross topping at 172ppk from the same home. Overage heifers sold to 196ppk from Palmallet.

A small show of stores maintained recent high rates topping at £1190 for Luig steers from High Ardwell with heifers to £1170 for Simmental cross from High Borgue. Top price per kilo was 252.5 for a pen of Charolais cross steers from Kenmure, Kirkcowan with Charolais cross heifers from the same home selling to 229.6ppk.
