



## **WALLETS MARTS CASTLE DOUGLAS LIMITED**

### **OTM, STORE CATTLE & BREEDING CATTLE MONDAY 23<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER 2017**

Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited held their fortnightly sale of store and OTM cattle on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2017.

A small show of store cattle were presented and were in general a plainer quality show which reflected in the trade. Weathered sorts were particularly hard to cash whilst better fleshed quality animals easily found homes. Topping the sale at £1100 was a Stabiliser heifer from J Paterson & Co, Kildarroch. Heifers also topped at 194.2p per kg for AA crosses from Rowen Hurst, Low Craiglemine. Bullocks sold to £1040 for a Limousin from Glen Farming Co and to 204.5p per kg for Limousins from Rowen Hurst, Low Craiglemine.

The OTM ring witnessed a better quality show than a fortnight ago albeit short of numbers. Topping the sale at 190p per kg was a Charolais heifer from Lochside Ltd whilst cows sold to 140p per kg or £1089.20 for a British Blue from T Robb, Trolane. Overall average was 126.6p per kg.
