Lambs sold to £114 x 2 firstly for heavy Suffolks from Hiddleston, Newmains then for heavy Texels from Douganhill Farms, Palnackie. Top per kilo was 241.7 for the Champion Texels from Messrs Watson, Slatehouse, Moniave.
