Wallets Marts Castle Douglas Limited continued their fortnightly sales of Store and OTM cattle on Monday 10th September when they sold 185 cattle.

Store cattle met with a good demand with quality sorts being easiest sold. Topping the bullock section at £1145 were a pair of Limousin bullocks from T Robb, Trolane, Dalry. Top price per kg for bullocks was 226.3p paid to Cardoness & Kings Laggan for a pen of Limousins. Heifers sold to £1170 and 230.3p for a pen of 3 Limousins also from Trolane. Bullocks averaged 206.4ppk whilst heifers levelled at 200.3ppk

OTM cattle once again met a buoyant demand topping at 140p for a Limousin cross from Lower Ardmannoch, Knockvennie. Cast bulls sold to 117p per kg or £1139.58 for a Shorthorn from J Biggar, Grange. Sale average was 119.9p per kg.
